When a rich man, who has money and possessions in great plenty, believes that he will not die of hunger during the year, this is not called faith. But that man is really a believer who, without anything on hand, nevertheless clings to God's Word, convinced that as a Father God will supply him with sustenance as long as he keeps himself in the fear of God and attends to his calling.
