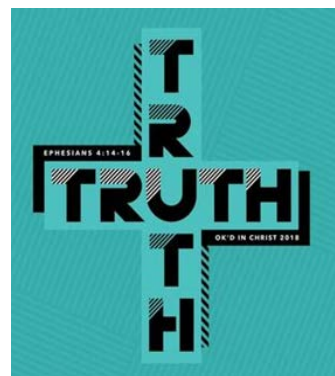
YOUTH NEWS
