Martin Luther on MIRACLES. (In a sermon on John 4:47-54 Luther points out the purpose of Christ's miracles as they were intended to point the people back to the Word of God.)

THE PURPOSE OF CHRIST'S MIRACLES. Christ says in effect that faith should not rest on signs and wonders alone but on the Word. For signs and wonders may actually be false and untrue; but he who builds on the Word cannot be deceived, because God's promise is certain and cannot lie. Although the Lord performed signs and wonders in order to let Himself be seen and move people to faith, He nonetheless wanted people to look more at the Word than at the signs, which were intended to serve as a testimony to the Word. For it was not His main purpose to give this or that sick person bodily aid; it was His most important office to direct people to the Word and to impress it on their hearts, so that they should be saved.
