Martin Luther on MIRACLES. (In his 1532 exposition of Matthew 7:22-23, Luther states a great truth about miracles.)

The rule is this: **regardless of their size and number, no wonders or signs are to be accepted contrary to established teaching.** We have God's commandment, in fact, He has commanded from heaven about Christ: **Listen to Him. Christ is the only One to whom you should listen.** In addition, we have this warning, that false prophets will come and do great signs, but that they are all on the wrong track, away from Christ and toward something different. The only preventive is to have a good grasp of the doctrine and to keep it before your eyes continually.
