**Martin Luther on HELPING THE SICK.** (In 1527, when the plague struck Wittenberg, Luther gave advice that government officials and pastors should not flee from the plague but stay and care for the afflicted.)

**DEFY THE DEVIL BY HELPING THE SICK.** Get away, you devil, with your terrors! Just because you hate it, I'll spite you by going the more quickly to help my sick neighbor. I'll pay no attention to you. I've got two heavy blows to use against you: the first one is that I know that helping my neighbor is a deed well-pleasing to God... Should not my dear Christ, with His precepts, His kindness, and all His encouragement, be more important in my spirit than you, roguish devil, with your false terrors in my weak flesh? ... The second blow against the devil is God's mighty promise by which He encourages those who minister to the needy. He says in Psalm 41:1-3, "**Blessed is he who considers the poor.**" What should terrorize us or frighten us away from such great and divine comfort?
