**Martin Luther on GOD'S WILL.** (In his exposition of John 7:17 ON July 1, 1531, Luther wrote that we should look to God's will in order to receive, not in order to reason.)

**It Is God's Will That We Hear and Heed His Word.** It is the will of the Father that we see and hear what the Man Christ says and that we listen to His Word. You are not to cavil (*quibble*) at His Word, not criticize it or argue about it; you are to hear it. Then the Holy Spirit will come and well prepare your heart to enable you to say: **This is God's Word and the pure truth; sacrifice your life for the love of it.** But if you want people to hear you and to explain Christ's Word according to our reason... that is not listening or being a pupil but being a master. In this way you would never arrive at an understanding of Christ's Word... Stop your reasoning, tread on your wisdom, and do not allow it to grope, feel, or think in matters pertaining to your salvation; but simply and only hear what the Son of God says, what His Word is. Resolve to stop there. This is doing the will of our Lord God purely and properly.
