**Martin Luther on RESURRECTION.** (Luther appreciated how the Apostle Paul placed the resurrection central in the body of Christian teachings. He makes his conviction clear in his 1522 exposition of 1 Peter 1:3 in which he also quoted 1 Corinthians 15:13.)

**“If There Be No Resurrection...”** He who would preach the Gospel must go directly to preaching the resurrection of Christ. He who does not preach the resurrection is no apostle, for this is the chief part of our faith.... The greatest importance attaches to this article of faith. For were there no resurrection, we would have neither comfort nor hope, and everything else Christ did and suffered would be in vain.
