An Article of Faith in the Word. If you want to judge according to what you see and feel and, when the Word of God is set before you, want to pit your feeling against it and say: "You tell me much; but my heart speaks a different language, and if you felt what I feel, you, too, would speak differently" – then you do not have the Word of God in the heart but have quenched and extinguished it by your own thoughts, reason, and brooding. In short, if you will not let the Word mean more to you than all your feeling, eyes, senses, and heart, you must be lost, and there is no further help for you. For we are concerned with an article of *faith*, not an article of your reason or ability. Therefore you must judge solely according to the Word in this matter, irrespective of what you feel and see.
