Martin Luther on the RESURRECTION: (From Luther's Easter sermon of 1530 on Mark 16:1-8, he emphasizes that a Christian faces his spiritual enemies with bold defiance because of the Easter victory given him through the Lord Jesus Christ.)

The Christian Is Triumphantly Certain. Know ye, then – *sin, death, devil, and everything that assails me* – that you are missing the mark. I am not one of those who are afraid of you. For Christ, my dear Lord, has presented to me that triumph and victory of His by which you were laid low. And from this very gift of His I derive my name and am called a Christian. There is no other reason. My sin and death hung about His neck on Good Friday, but on the day of Easter they had completely disappeared. This victory He has bestowed on me! This is why I do not worry about you!
