Martin Luther on RESURRECTION. (In a sermon preached on May 25, 1544 at the Wittenberg parish church, Luther expounded on 1 Corinthians 15:39-44 to talk about the resurrected body of believers.)

New Bodies of Resurrected Believers. After a man's body has decayed in the earth, it will rise in much greater beauty and glory. It will be the body of a human being, just as it was created; but the body will have a different appearance and use. It will not eat, drink, digest, procreate children, keep house, etc. It will need none of the things that pertain to this transient life and bodily sustenance... The difference between man and woman, which God established in creation, will continue just as grain keeps its nature and its characteristics... Nature was so created and by the Word so continues that every creature will bear fruit after its kind and have its own seed within itself, each according to its kind. In like manner God will give to each his or her own body at the resurrection. What was created a human being will remain a human being, whether man or woman.
