Martin Luther on PARENTING. (In a sermon on the 4th Commandment on November 5, 1525, Luther condemns the spiritual neglect of children by their parents.)

Shameful Neglect of Children's Souls. There is indeed the commandment that parents are to bring up their children in the fear of God; but where are the parents who do it? To be sure, they love their children as the world loves, and they bring them up to know how they must fit themselves into the pattern of the world; but there is no one really to instruct and teach them the care of their souls in the fear of God. Just observe the attitude people take toward this matter, what sort of schools are kept throughout the entire country. No one teaches his children how to pray properly and the matters pertaining to salvation... Some animals devour their own young and destroy their own fruit. People who do not teach and instruct their children are like that. In fact, if you want to consider their matter from the standpoint of the soul, there is no animal on earth which is as hard toward its young as a human being.

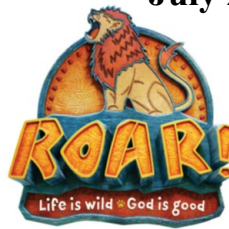

Dear HTLC family:

Thank you for all the prayers, cards, visits and well wishes following my stroke event. You have only to go through a near-death experience and come out on the other side relatively unscathed to understand the great power of prayer and the Lord's hand in your life. With a massive stroke cutting off three-quarters of the blood flow to my brain, the hand of God orchestrated 12 events occurring in a set sequence to save my life! As weird as it sounds, one of those was the gurney getting stuck in the back of the first ambulance that came to pick me up. Because of my ultimately discovered condition, that ambulance, scheduled to take me to a different facility, would have only had to transfer me to the major facility I ended up at, wasting about one hour of valuable life-saving time. The second ambulance called transported me directly to the facility needed, where amazingly, the only surgeon who could do the procedure I needed was on call that night, immediately taking the action needed to save me.

I have been encouraged to share the ordeal and my "12 miracles" in a book and perhaps God will inspire me to share the entire event to stress the importance of time management in a stroke event.

The scariest part of the entire ordeal may be trying to figure out what our gracious God has cooked up for me in the future by plucking this sinner from death's door step. May I be the instrument He needs in His hands as I move into the future with cherished moments of extended time with family and friends as I explore this new lease on life!
