Martin Luther on the CHRISTIAN. (On June 24, 1522, which is the day commemorating John the Baptist, Luther preached a sermon on Luke 1:57-80 distinguishing between "doctrine" and "Christian life".)

An Evil Life is Bad, But Bad Doctrine Is Worse. Doctrine and life are different things. Therefore you should distinguish them very well, for God is not so much concerned about life as He is about doctrine. Therefore He often permits His own to stumble, as we read. But when doctrine is concerned, He has not allowed them to budge a hairsbreadth, for an evil life is not nearly so harmful as an evil doctrine. An evil life harms no one more than him who leads it, but evil doctrine often misleads an entire country... The saints of old are to be honored far more for the sake of doctrine than for the sake of their life.

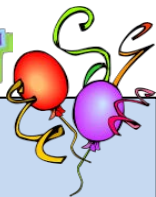
