**Answer:** He has told us by saying, "Now are ye clean through the word which I have spoken unto you" (John 15:3). Hence we are not to look at the size and the number of works which men do, for all of these are still no more than works which even non-Christians and rogues are able to do and perform. Rather we are, above all things, to watch their lips, to note whether what they teach and believe is the pure Word of Christ or not.
