Martin Luther on THE CHURCH. (In June of 1539, Luther remarked informally to those gathered around his table about the difference in the government between the Church and the State.)

Church and State Work Differently. The difference between ecclesiastical and political power is to be well observed. For the power of the Church consists in preaching the Word of God, consoling afflicted consciences by absolution, and excommunicating the impenitent, without inflicting corporal punishment. But the political power bears the sword, because it is an administration which handles the guilty by laws and honest judgments and corporal punishments. The former is without external power; the latter has the power of capital punishment.

Braille Work Center Ministry Celebrates 1-year anniversary

Since beginning the work in late July of 2017, a very faithful group of 40 HTLC volunteers have met weekly to emboss, collate, and package over 900 volumes consisting of over 54,000 pages of braille. These volumes have been distributed to recipients in 36 states and 19 foreign countries. We praise God for providing the opportunity to serve people in His Kingdom who are blind, by producing and mailing braille books of the Bible.
