**Martin Luther on THE CHRISTIAN.** (In 1539 Luther was recorded to have given the following advice about Christian citizens in a lawless or punitive environment.)

#### As a Citizen a Christian Has the Right to Defend Himself.

The Christian is a person that lives in two spheres, to wit, he is a believer and a citizen. A believer suffers everything, does not eat, does not drink, and does not beget children. But a citizen is subject to the laws and the legal code and is forced to defend himself and to uphold the peace. If, then, someone wanted to put my wife and girls to shame in my sight, I should put the Christian into the background and act in the capacity of a citizen, kill him in the act, or cry for help. For in the absence of governmental authority the people are the authority. Neighbors may then be called on to help. For Christ did not abolish laws and state authorities; He confirmed them.
