Martin Luther on FAITH. (In a Pentecost sermon on John 3:16-21, Luther points out that faith alone in the words of Christ brings salvation.)

Faith is the Hand That Merely Takes. In what manner do we lay hold of this treasure and gift of salvation, or what is the purse or chest into which we are to put it? It is faith alone... It holds out the hand and opens the bag and is content to receive nothing but benefactions. For as God, the Giver, moved by His love, bestows these blessings upon us, so we are the recipients through faith, which does nothing but accept the gift. For salvation is not our doing and cannot be merited by our work; it already exists, presented and bestowed. Only see that you open your mouth, or rather your heart, be still, and let yourself be filled. This cannot be done except by your believing the words.

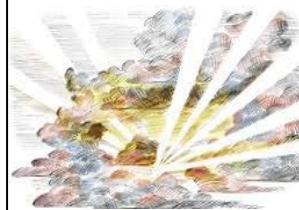

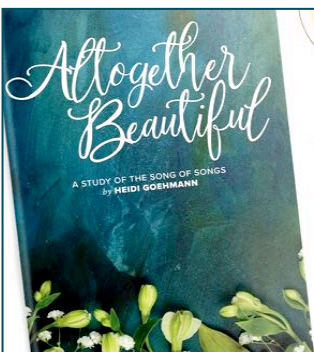
