Martin Luther on CHRIST THE KING. (As pertaining to Christ ruling as King, Luther is recorded as saying in 1531 that Christ will rule despite all opposition, even when the world does not recognize or acknowledge His divine rule.)

Christ Shall Rule Despite All Opposition. The Man who sits at the right hand of the Father (Psalm 110:1) insists on ruling, but the world will not put up with Him and says: **"We will not have this man to reign over us"** (Luke 19:4). Yet He must rule for the sake of Him who says: **"Sit at My right hand"** (Psalm 110:1).
